

Oil / Gas

Citronelle's oil and gas roots date back to 1955 when the biggest oil field east of the Mississippi River, at the time, was discovered in Citronelle. Citronelle produced 160 million barrels of oil 12,000 feet down becoming Alabama's only "giant" oil field, which is a field that produces more than 100 barrels. Over time more than 500 wells would be drilled in Citronelle going as deep as 20,000 feet below the surface.

Due to our history with oil and gas, we are a perfect location for suppliers of the industry to locate. Our 2-county labor shed has the following amounts of employees employed in the oil and gas sectors:

- 1,182 employed in Crude Petroleum and Natural Gas Extraction
- 314 employed in Oil and Gas Field Machinery & Equipment Manufacturing
- 186 employed in Petroleum Products Merchants Wholesalers
- 175 employed in Natural Gas Distribution
- 147 employed in Pipeline Transportation of Natural Gas
- 124 employed in Support Activities for Oil and Gas Operations
- 80 employed in Petroleum Bulk Stations and Terminals
- 74 employed in Oil and Gas Pipeline Construction
- 56 employed in Petroleum and Coal Products Manufacturing
- 26 employed in Drilling Oil and Gas Wells

Also, the oil and gas sectors are growing in our 2-county labor shed by the amounts as follows:

- 73% growth since 2010 in people employed in Drilling Oil and Gas Wells
- 59% growth since 2010 in Oil and Gas Field Machinery & Equipment Manufacturing
- 57% growth since 2010 in people employed in Support Activities for Oil and Gas Operations
- 54% growth since 2010 in people employed in Natural Gas Distribution
- 29% growth since 2010 in people employed in Crude Petroleum and Natural Gas Extraction
